

Need help finding scholarly journal articles? Follow the steps below.

## Find an Article

1) Go to the Gabriele Library homepage (<http://library.immaculata.edu>).

2) Click on “Find an Article”.



3) Click on “Subject Guide to Databases”.

Subject Guide to Databases

4) Choose the subject that corresponds to your topic (e.g. Business & Economics).

5) Click on the first database listed under that subject.

[Note: When accessing the databases off-campus, you will be prompted to log-in with your network ID.]

6) Type your keywords in the search box and click on “Search”.

7) Limit your search to “full-text” if you wish to access the full article today.

8) Limit your search to “scholarly/peer-reviewed journals” if you do not wish to get magazine or newspaper articles.

9) Limit your search by Date, Subject, Geography, etc. to get more relevant results.

10) If you find a relevant article, click on the pdf link. From here, you can print, save, or email the article to yourself. (If it’s not available in full-text, you may request the article through inter-library loan.)

11) Repeat these steps with a different database listed under your subject to find additional journal articles.
