

Do you want to see if the library owns a particular journal? Follow the steps below.

List of Journals

1) Go to the Gabriele Library homepage (<http://library.immaculata.edu>).

2) Click on “List of Journals”.



3) Type the journal name in the search box and click on “Search”.

Option #1: If there a database listed under the journal name, click on it, then proceed to Step #4.

Option #2: If there is more than one database listed, choose the one that includes your date range and proceed to Step #4.

Option #3: If it says “Print, Check Library Catalog” under the database name, go to the second floor of the library and find the print journal.

Option #4: If it says “Sorry, this search returned no results”, that means we do not own the journal. Follow the instructions for requesting materials through Inter-Library loan.

4) Once in the database, you may browse for a particular volume or issue number, or you can search for a specific article title by clicking on “Search within this publication”.

5) Type your article title in the empty search box and click “Search”.

6) Once you locate the article, click on the pdf link. From here, you can save, print, or email the article to yourself.
