All students have 24/7 access to a Library Moodle site for research help, whether or not they have a class in Moodle. You can find the Library & Research Help Group under the **Resources** block.

What you need to know:



Having trouble logging in? The library resources are protected by an additional log-in screen (**This is different than your Moodle log-in!**).

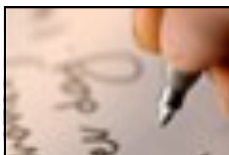
When prompted, use the same username as you do in Moodle (e.g. jsmith1). Your password is the last 6 digits of your Student ID. This ID number can be found on a bill, class schedule, or other university communications. You can also find your ID number online under your class schedule in SSIU.



Looking for scholarly articles?

Locate your subject's page under the **Find an Article** folder. Pages are available for each major discipline as well as a list of "General Databases".

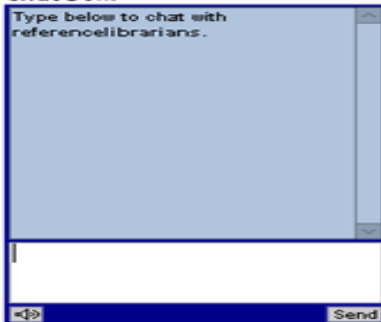
Are you too far away from Immaculata to visit Gabriele Library?
