

**Cloudpath IUBYOD Wireless Authentication  
IUWIFI-New Wireless Network Instruction  
(Personal Devices Only)**

Getting Started..

1. Go to the wireless settings on the device you are trying to connect.
2. Find the IUWifi – Start Here network and click on it.
  - Windows:
    - Your PC should automatically open a browser to the wireless registration wizard page.
  - Apple Mac/iPhone/iPad/Android/Chromebook:
    - Once you have connected, please open a browser, and to <https://www.immaculata.edu>
      - NOTE: You need to go to the IU Webpage, so if you are using Chrome or a browser that directs you to a Search Engine Page for IU then you need to click on the web link for the IU Webpage.
      - NOTE: If you get a “THIS CONNECTION IS NOT PRIVATE” message – Click on SHOW DETAILS and then at the bottom select VISIT THIS WEBSITE. This is an error commonly seen with IOS devices.
3. Once connected, you will be presented with the terms and conditions. Please carefully read the instructions and then select START to accept and begin the login process.
4. You will be sent to MyIU to authenticate your account. Please enter your Immaculata username and password.
5. The next page is the Welcome to the Immaculata University Wireless Network Page. Please read this information and then select Continue.
6. You will now be given your wireless password. This password can be used to connect to the IUBYOD (IU Bring-Your-Own-Device) wireless network. This password is unique to you and should only be used by you. Everyone is authorized to have up to 10 device connections with this password. A copy of your password will be emailed to you at your Immaculata email.
7. You will no longer need to be connected to **IUWIFI - Start Here**. Go to your known wireless networks and 'FORGET' this network from your device.
8. Please use your new **IUBYOD** Password to connect to the **IUBYOD** Network.

**Congratulations - you are now connected to the Immaculata University Bring Your Own Device Wireless Network.**

**\*\*Please Note:** These instructions are for students, staff, and faculty to connect their personal devices. Immaculata University owned devices (laptops, iPads, iPhone, and other devices) should not be connected to this network. For university owned laptop and PC's, a wireless configuration is automatically deployed to the device.
